Sunday of the Samaritan Woman May 15, 2022 Неділя Самарянки

#### Христос Воскрес! **Christ is Risen!**

Today's Sunday Gospel offers us a rich reflection about what Jesus - our one and only Saviour - really wants us to understand about our role in His Church's mission of bringing salvation to all people.

The Woman at the well had lived a very complicated life. In fact, Biblical scholars point out that her shame in the community was the probable reason for her coming out at that time of day to draw water - when few if any people





would be out in the streets. Jesus, of course, intended to encounter her there. He reached out to her by talking to her and giving her a chance to do something extraordinarily charitable: not only giving water to a stranger, but to a stranger of a people whom her people absolutely tried to avoid (there was a mutual dislike and distrust). Well, the woman enters into conversation with Jesus; she decides to be honest about who she is, her past and where she is at right then in her life. The Lord, Who needs us to be honest with ourselves and with Him before He can do anything with us, commends the woman. And, the rest is history. The woman knows that she is experiencing an unbelievable encounter. She is able to return to her people in town to share with them the good news of the presence of Christ. Her head is held high for the first time in a long time. It is interesting that she doesn't keep this encounter and grace for herself. She wants everyone to get in on it!... even those who had not thought very highly about her, or who had even hurt her. Let us have that same spirit. When we have the joy of God in our hearts, let's share it with those around us-even those that have decided not to associate with us or with whom we don't care to associate. Why? Because they are God's children, too, and thus are our brothers and sisters. We want all of our brothers and sisters to have the same conversion that we seek and have life - Fr. Michael everlasting!

the Son, we, too, are raised up and exalted with the Lord into the Kingdom of God. The Divine Liturgy puts us spiritually and physically in the presence of God. Even more amazing is that if we worthily receive Holy Communion, we have a foretaste of heaven by becoming one with God. Let us request this powerful prayer for our loved ones: a liturgy of thanksgiving for your marriage? your health? success in school? Prayer works wonders, and demonstrates gratitude to God. Tell your loved one that it is for them and that you will be there, too, in person to be part of the prayer...




