

# Dear Parishioners! Christ is Risen! Христос Воскрес!

This Sunday is rich with challenges and opportunities. Today we ask ourselves what does it take for me to truly declare my love for and belief in the risen Jesus Christ as my one and only God and Saviour - to whom I dedicate my life 100% in the hopes of obtaining life everlasting? St. Thomas for various reasons (because he was a practical pragmatic kind of guy?... he was kind of hurt that everyone had a personal encounter with the risen Lord except him? who knows) wanted not only to see the risen Jesus, but actually touch His wounds to verify that what he was seeing was truly Jesus and was not just a vision of some sort. Well, he was granted his request. In a nano-second St Thomas was ready and willing to exclaim his faith that Jesus was truly, "my Lord and my God!". St Thomas went to Babylon and established the first Church in that country. In fact, he preached

the Gospel in Persia, China, and India. The Syro-Malabar Eastern Christians in India are known as the "St Thomas Christians" to this day. It was while he was Evangelizing in India that St. Thomas was martyred December 21st. **Today we celebrate**—at least in spirit—**Easter** again with our brothers and sisters in Ukraine. In fact, it is not only in spirit, but

in faith, as we pray the Eucharistic Liturgy today and WE ARE ALL INVITED TO COME DOWN after the 1st (8 AM) and the 2nd (10 AM) Divine Liturgies through to the all-purpose room for some Easter fellowship with Paskha, eggs, kovbasa and more! Please come for this parish get-together. Yes - We continue our prayer for Ukraine and today - with many thousands of local Christian communities and churches and parishes throughout Canada (see p. 2,#2) as we pray a special prayer for an end to the war in Ukraine and a restoration of justice.

This **Passion Week** and **Easter** were truly a balm and restoration to the soul after the long Covid cloud of uncertainty and restrictions. Then there was the long (notover-yet?) winter and then the trauma of the horrific Russian invasion of Ukraine (and the seeming hesitancy of the west to adequately come to her aid!?). Yet we had - in spite of everything - a great parish experience! Volunteers came together to put up the tomb, and then participate in the services - especially Easter Sunday morning (wow!) and the various singers throughout the services gave their heart and soul! (The singers on Easter Sunday early were obviously pumped about the feast and they shook the walls!) One can feel that we have set out on a new enthusiastic course. - 5. Knights of Columbus (Canon Luhovy Assembly) invites all to come for **an evening of PRAYER for UKRAINE this coming Tuesday at 6 PM** (St. Nicholas church on Bannerman). Please make the effort!
- 6. Always the gentlemen! The Knights of Columbus (Fr. Filipow Council, St. Nicholas Parish) are **cancelling** their June Garage Sale, since so many of the items meant for sale are actually being put into service for the refugees from Ukraine.
