Dear Parishioners

Glory to Jesus Christ! Слава Ісусу Христу!

The world is focused on the surreal invasion of Ukraine by the Russia. The number of fatalities and wounded rises as you read this. The destruction of homes, neighbourhoods, local and national infrastructure that will burden society for years to come. The people of Ukraine and people of good will throughout the world those that appreciate the threat that this means for global peace - have begun to pray earnestly and continuously. We do the same. dangers pandemic all related and restrictions put a cloud over our lives for a long period, and really complicate our practice of that most dear to us - our Faith. Now our brothers and sisters in Ukraine (many of our relatives and friends) are actually at war. We may be limited as to what we can do, but we certainly can and must pray.

Although our sights are set mostly on Ukraine, we need to continue our life of prayer and spiritual growth for our own salvation and to be of great help to those around us. We find ourselves on the very eve of the Great Fast (Lent) and we begin this life changing journey by putting our house in order as best we can. One of the most important and essential aspects of preparing for the 40+day trip ahead is to forgive and be forgiven. The Lord designed, us body and soul, so He truly knows what makes us tick and what we need to be successful and to be happy. He made it very clear that we need a clear conscience and we need peace of mind and heart if we are to know

peace and accomplish anything worthwhile in this life. **FORGIVENESS SUNDAY** gives us the perfect opportunity to ponder our relationship with God and with each and every person in our life - past and present. Let us call to mind those we might have hurt, betrayed,

neglected as well as those who we feel did such things to us. Let us ask God for the grace to forgive those who may have hurt us (and those dear to us) and for the courage to ask forgiveness of those we may have harmed. If we can do it right out the gate - fantastic! If it will take a bit of time, then let's work on it and deal with it as soon as possible! (like in the next little while, not in several years). We have a lot we can and must do with our Lord! The baggage of hurt and grudges and guilt will just slow us

down and hinder us all together. Remember the movie The Mission and how the soldier who lived a terrible life (and even killed his brother) knew that he needed to do penance and obtain forgiveness. The time came when he allowed them

to cut the burden off of him and he cried with relief and joy. Let's do this...

We will have to elect/confirm officers and review our finances, but there are a lot of other things that we should touch upon.... Our Centenary Celebrations, Our Future, and our Success in fulfilling our Gospel Mission, or as Jesus put it, "Go rather to the lost sheep of Israel. Come with ideas and enthusiasm and a truckload of good will! but, especially - COME!

Come in-person or attend online (a Zoom link will be send to parishioners with this bulletin)

- **2. FORGIVENESS SUNDAY: TODAY.** We begin Lent / the Great Fast tonight with a forgiveness service to which everyone is warmly invited. It will involve a Repentance service and then an opportunity to ask for and express forgiveness to all the members of our parish community before we begin the journey of Lent together. **That's 6 PM tonight.**
- 3. This Week's —"I BELIEVE! BIPYIO!" Zoom discussion Wednesday evening at 7 PM! The session begins with a starting lesson, then we discuss the theme or other topics of your interest. It is an excellent way to revisit the Faith, and to fill in the gaps we may have in our understanding of our relationship with our Lord and His Church. These are open to all parishioners (yes YOU too!) so, watch for the email from our Parish Office with the Zoom link. This Wednesday's theme: "He has spoken through the Prophets"
- **4**. This week: First Friday. Please come for the Stations of the Cross at 7PM, followed by a Holy Hour during which Father Michael will be hearing confessions.
- 5. Way of the Cross: every Friday during Lent at 7 PM. This Wednesday as well, at 5:30 PM, come for the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts.
- **6**. **World Day of Prayer March 4, 2022 at 7PM,** in-person and via stream on The service will be at *Atlantic-Garden City United Church, 725 Atlantic Ave* (corner of Atlantic and Arlington). You will need to show proof of vaccination and wear a mask. - **7**. A weekly (10 meetings) online course from the States titled Iconography as Visual Theology is offered: *March 7, 10, 14, 16, 18, 31* and April *4, 6, 8, 11* (4 PM 6 PM EST) Cost: \$90 USD, with a certificate at the end (or 3 course credits for more \$). - **8. SAVE THE DATES.** Being Winnipeg's '*Marian Parish*', we are planning a **Lenten Mini Mission** around the feast of the **Annunciation** in the 4th week of the Great Fast 23-25 of March. Watch for details about this special event and other retreats and missions in the city this Lent.
- **9**. Remember that **weekly** devotions continue at **Blessed Vasyl' Martyr's Shrine** (250 Jefferson Ave) right here in Winnipeg! During *Lent* they will take place on *Tuesday*! akafist or a moleben' and an inspirational talk/homily related to this bishop and martyr. **www.bvmartyrshrine.com**
- **10.** Besides 2022 being the Year of the Tiger (*Chinese tradition*) and the "Year of Practical Thinking" (*Atlantic magazine*), it has also been proclaimed in Canada as the "**Year of the Garden**." How's this for an idea: we look at our souls this Lent, and use the following weeks to make the best "garden" ever for God, weeding out the crabbiness... er... crabgrass and other "weeds", and planting those lovely seeds of patience...kindness...pure thinking and so on.

What an amazing and joy-filled Easter would follow! Right, then. Come to confession this Friday and your parish priest will have the "shears" to start the pruning of all those "branches and twigs" that we call sin. Let's make this truly the BEST. LENT. EVER!

The Marriage Box - Every week, we will pull two new tips out of our box from different resources. Try to follow each tip throughout the week and see what comes of it. If you and your spouse have any successful extra tips, let us know and we'll add them!

20. Don't stonewall your partner! You know what I'm talking about...when during an argument you stop talking and maintain a very cool exterior, showing your partner that you don't care at all

about what he/she is saying. This is very destructive. What to do instead? Ask for a break. Tell your partner that you're feeling emotionally overwhelmed and go for a walk or otherwise put your brain on ice until you've cooled your jets. Then, return to the discussion — sooner rather than later — and continue the discourse.

21. Use a code word. This word can be used for two things: a signal to your partner that (at a party, for instance) you are pleading: "Let's get out of here right now!". But it can also mean, when the two of you are arguing, that you need to leave the argument for a later time, and are asking your husband/wife to stop cold, with a promise to resume later that day. Can't hurt to try! (Ha... so what would *your* family code word be.... Minneapolis? ... helicopter?... kapusta?)

This is *Forgiveness Sunday*... as we begin Lent, maybe an attempt at mutual forgiveness - at least in some area(s) would provide a fresh start in the marriage.... (?)


