Problems abound in this world, and every problem needs a solution. But... solutions always come at a cost. The reason most people procrastinate, or never seem to find a solution to their problems, is that they wonder if the cost isn't "too great":

"I would have to get up earlier." "I would have to smile (sincerely) at my enemy." "I would have to post-pone my vacation until next year." "I would have to raise this child by myself." "Everybody would laugh at me if I admitted that I…" and on and on.

Chances are that the village in today's Gospel was filled with rather opulent (for the times) pig farmers. By healing the demonized man, and sending the demons into the swine, who then hurtled into the water and drowned... could Jesus have been showing the townspeople that money wasn't

everything? That they had to quit worrying so much about their pigs' market value, and start thinking about God more?

But no. They actually, basically shooed Our Lord right out of their town tout de suite.

What problems do WE have right now, that we have been asking Our Lord to help us solve? Is there a giving us chance He has been solutions, but that we don't recognize

them, because we have an inherent understanding of the likely cost to us? Are we languishing in a life that is not great

(or even miserable), because we lack the faith to trust in Lord's promise of a new life not only in the Resurrection, but already now?

We are excited to be celebrating the first century of our parish. It was established by people who came before us and, by the grace of God and by our dedicated collaboration with that grace, BVM will be thriving **long after** we have gone on our just reward as promised by our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ (Jn 5:29). But, although we want to take a bit of a "sentimental journey" this year, we want to be sure that our gaze focused on the present and the future. We want to remind ourselves that this is our parish, but not ours exclusively. Several parishes have set up "Newcomer Assistance Committees" that have collaborated with the support




of the Archeparchy to offer a **Summer Day Camp** to provide a safe, fun and reliable option for Ukrainian Newcomer families and their children.
