In light of the heightened activity surrounding the Newcomers from Ukraine on the part of our Archeparchy, other faith communities and organizations such as the Ukrainian Canadian Congress, His Grace, Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak, wants to encourage all our Faithful to continue supporting the refugee-help efforts. A lot of volunteers and financial resources are needed as more and more newcomers arrive in Manitoba every day. There is a need for housing, jobs and mentorship to help our brothers and sisters who have left their destroyed homes to escape the death and horrors of war. Also, aside from typical newcomer challenges, there are incidents like the newcomer who was assaulted at the Forks. Please, continue to donate toward aid to refugees via the charities that we have promoted since the beginning of the war. 4. **The Holy Father Pope Francis is coming to Canada next week!** Whether you will be home, or vacationing elsewhere, be aware of his itinerary, and pray for him and for all those he will be meeting. (If you don't pray, who will?)

Did you know that many parishes throughout Canada are trying to help in any way they can, to promote reconciliation? Some have sponsored short conferences about Healing and Indigenous Reconciliation. Some have been praying novenas together. A parish in Saskatoon is sponsoring a busload of parishioners of a nearby Indigenous, First Nations and Metis Catholic parish, to go and take part in the Edmonton papal visit events. These are all beautiful gestures of good will and Christian love. Let us all grow in such love and healing by being ready to help others anytime, everywhere we go. At a minimum, let us continue to pray for each other.

5. **Second World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly: next Sunday, July 24, 2022.** Pope Francis invites all dioceses and eparchies to celebrate this day together to ensure "no one lives this day in loneliness." The theme chosen by the Holy Father for the occasion is "In old age they will still bear fruit" (Ps 92:15).
