

Assessment from a distance...

One of the great things about the summer season is that hands-on activity in the parish DOES slow down a bit (at least for some), which gives everyone an opportunity to assess matters and assess needs in a non-hectic atmosphere and plan for the immediate future. That is how spiritual retreats are supposed to work. One withdraws from the activity and numerous distractions of everyday life to spend time in prayer, to hear some unique ideas and to prepare oneself to jump back into the fray of everyday life with renewed insights and energy. Well, summer in a parish can work in a similar way. Parish organizations (including Parish Pastoral Councils) cease their regular meetings.... Parish events (dinners, etc.) are put on hold until the fall time... Programs like Catechism are also suspended until the beginning of a new Church Year in September... and, what do we do? Well, we attend the Divine Liturgy on Sundays and Feast Days, we participate in uplifting events like the Cooks Creek Pilgrimage and we contemplate how our 2022/2023 Parish Year is going to unfold.

Catechism? Hey, maybe I can get involved in teaching this year. (It would challenge me to brush up on my knowledge of the Faith as I prepare for lessons). Altar Servers and Children of Mary? (I used to love belonging to those myself, I



want my children to get involved and, hey, maybe I will volunteer to help out myself). Men's Club, Knights of Columbus, Seniors Club? (What am I waiting for? Maybe I should step forward to start a tiny group and see how it develops). Ukrainian Language and Culture? (I would love to learn some practical Ukrainian, I should express this and see what kind of a learning group we can put together...even a weekly singsong of classic Ukrainian folksongs and contemporary hits. Maybe I can bring my family!) What about a program for our Newcomers from Ukraine? (English language, rides here and there, "mentorship" – offering a friendly, helping hand from time to time). We want to plan and share ideas NOW and 'psych ourselves up' to be able to say, "yes, I would participate" "yes, I would help out" "yes, I would love to see that happening at my parish and I will help make it happen". We are celebrating 100 really good years. Could the next 100 be even better? Of course! More Christian spirit... better understanding of our faith and what we have to contribute to the world... reaching out to and welcoming our neighbours according to our Christian mandate of bringing all to know the truth and love of Christ... and just enjoying our Ukrainian Catholic faith as we have every right to do. But we have to make it happen and we can!
