Our own parish:



for Ukrainian Newcomer Children

BACKGROUND

We are looking for Summer Day Camp Leaders to lead a Summer Day Camp for Ukrainian newcomer children from 5-14 years of age. This camp is an excellent opportunity for you to welcome and assist Ukrainian children in becoming familiar and comfortable in Canada.

With the support of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy and UCC-MPC, several Ukrainian Catholic parishes are filling a gap in providing care for Ukrainian children newcomers during the summer months. We know many newcomers arrived with one parent (based on the requirement for the males to remain in Ukraine) and require summer childcare. Our initiative is to help newcomer parents with school-age children.

JOB TIMEFRAME

Camp leaders would be employed for ten weeks, with one week of planning followed by nine weeks of camp.

Start – June 27 to September 3 Hours – 40 hours per week.

Summer Camp counselors will work together to lead and deliver the summer camp program to Ukrainian newcomer children from ages 5 to 14. The counselors will run activities with the assistance of youth volunteers and special guests such as dance instructors, art instructors, English instructors, and sports instructors. The program will include at least one field trip outing per week.
