

Seek ye the Kingdom of God... and all this shall be added to you!

Слава Ісусу Христу! **Glory to Jesus Christ!**

Today, we celebrate the transferred Feast of Christ the Lover of Mankind! Yes, the Feast is relatively new to our Ukrainian Catholic Church (125+ years), but the concept of the love of Christ the Son of God for us, His People, has been around since creation, and

certainly since Jesus spoke those famous words we hear in today's Gospel reading: "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (Jn 3:16). What is our reaction to these words? If it is something akin to "awwwww isn't that nice? Jesus loves me", then we really need to spend a moment in serious thought and prayer. What these words are telling us is that our God - the one and only God - Who is all-powerful, omniscient (google it) and eternal (no beginning or end, ever) actually loves each and every one of us (yes, YOU too!), that He not only created us and created everything for us (including the billions of galaxies that we haven't barely begun to explore yet), but when we selfishly made a mess of things through sin, that He paid the only possible price by which one can repay a god (i.e. The God) and that is a sacrifice offered by God Himself.

Think about it: God the Son, offered Himself as an innocent and perfect sacrifice for our redemption. He did it for once and for all. He does not need to do it again, nor will He. He has paid the price and He has opened the door to the Kingdom of God and He has offered us Life Eternal. It is up to us to realize that there is no other such offer... no one will ever express such a mind-blowing love for us... what the Lord offers to us is eternal joy, beginning now from the moment of our opening our hearts to Him. What's the catch? None, except that we are actually given the freedom to accept it or reject it all. Our decision is made every day of our lives, by the way we respond to the grace that our Lord gives us. Our decision is made by every word, thought and action. By our faith - expressed by our words, thoughts and acts - we want to make and see progress. Oh, we all fall short of the grace of God. It takes the "best" of us a fair amount of trial and error to get it right. (Lord, spare us from making big mistakes!) However, the Lord did come into the world for the sake of our salvation. He wants nothing more than for each of us to succeed and join Him - Father, Son & Holy Spirit - for an eternal adventure of life and light in the Kingdom of Heaven. But, because of His love for us, He gives the opportunity to freely choose. He makes it clear that it is an eternal choice, and His promise and His salvation is eternal. However, when we choose wisely, then things are set in motion immediately. Let us not underestimate the love of God nor let



drive. Many items, some brand new,


were donated and will be much appreciated by the refugees. The items filled one van and one half ton extended cab truck.
