In what amazing times do we live! As we continue to watch aghast at what is happening in Ukraine today, we must remember the power of prayer. And, of all those who pray, the one our Lord is most willing to listen to is His own Mother!

Our Holy Father, Pope Frances, has requested all Bishops throughout the world to join him at exactly the same time on March 25 to consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, just as she requested in 1917 in Fatima! For us in Winnipeg, that means:

this coming Friday at 10 AM led by our Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak at our Blessed Virgin Mary Parish.

Special Daily Novena Prayer (March 17-25):

God of peace and justice, we pray for the people of Ukraine today. We pray for peace and the laying down of weapons. We pray for all those who fear for tomorrow, that your Spirit of comfort would draw near to them. We pray for those with power over war or peace, for wisdom, discernment and compassion to guide their decisions. Above all, we pray for all your precious children, at-risk and in fear, that you would hold and protect them. We pray in the name of Jesus, the Prince of Peace. Amen.

7. News from the Vatican -1) We already mentioned the special Consecration of Russia on March 25 by our Holy Father.

2) You probably knew that there has "always" been one Bishop in charge of the Slovaks (Byzantine rite) in Canada, and he was stationed in Toronto. But did you know that this eparchy has just been changed from an eparchy to an "exarchate", which means it has no permanent/local bishop in charge? The Vatican has transferred its jurisdiction "from the sui iuris metropolitan Church of Prešov of the Byzantines to that of **Pittsburgh** of the Byzantines, and ….has appointed Bishop Kurt Richard Burnette of Passaic of the Ruthenians, U.S.A., as "apostolic administrator sede" of the Toronto exarchate. Let us continue to pray for all bishops.
