

Dear Brothers and Sisters of our 100-year Blessed Virgin Mary Parish,

## Слава Iсусу Христу! Glory to Jesus Christ!

It is interesting that today's Gospel reading for this Sunday of the Holy Fathers is taken from what has come to known as the "Priestly Prayer" of Jesus: the chapters that lead up to the Last Supper, and then lead us through the Passion of the Christ. In this first part of the prayer, Jesus is asking from the depth of His heart that God the Father would grant us the grace and insights and holiness that we must have to live the *fulness of the gift of Faith* already won for us by Jesus. This "Priestly Prayer" really tugs at your heart (find time to read



the whole of chapter 17), because you sense the earnestness of Jesus as He knows that He is about to conclude His earthly mission...His sacred Heart is so heavy. He knows the horror and trauma that the Apostles and all His disciples are about to experience, seeing their teacher harshly arrested and mocked... mocked and lied about by the very religious leaders that should be at the forefront of His followers... then brutally put to death. What does Jesus pray for? That we would remember above all that we belong to God. He not only created us and saved us, but we have given ourselves to Him - and we must never forget this! Jesus prays that we will stick together and support each other through thick and thin; that we would not be easily scattered by the wolves of the society that does not accept Jesus. He prays that we never allow the decidedly godless society to push us to turn against each other and turn against God, but rather that we be a **light to the** 



**world** and convert the world away from the darkness and gloominess in which so many find themselves today.

We are called to shine the light of Christ on society and allow the peace and holiness and, yes, joy of the Gospel and the Teachings of our Catholic Church enlighten everyone around us. Like Christ, we too will have a heavy heart at times as we look at the world around us and see darkness and anger and frustration and fear and falsehood seemingly everywhere and seeming to be getting the upper hand. But yet there was no seemingly darker moment than when God the Son was being handed over to his hateful enemies to be abused and killed. What was Jesus action? To give up? To hide? To bring legions of Angels to defend Him? No. He stayed the course... fulfilling His mission to the very end, teaching and encouraging His followers to stay the course as well.

Christ God is victorious! Christ God will be victorious in the end as will be all those who stay faithful to Him and His Church. *- Fr. Michael*

There will be a lot of memories via pictures, chats and testimonies via an "open mic".



Please **NO** clothing.


