Слава Ісусу Христу! Glory to Jesus Christ!

Here we are at the beginning of a new year. For centuries, the Church - certainly the Byzantine Church (*to which the Ukrainian Church traces its roots*) – has seen the beginning of a new Church year at the ancient **indiction** (*imposition or assessment*) that predated the Emperor St Constantine's conversion and legalization of the Church. The new year in ancient Rome was September 1st (*before the Julian Calendar was chosen as the calendar of the western world*). In the Church we have maintained the beginning of September as our new ecclesial year. [*In the Roman Catholic Church, the beginning of their ecclesial year is the first Sunday of Advent before Christmas – i.e. somewhere at the end of November or the very beginning of December*].

The beginning of a Church year is the beginning of our Parish year. The Organizations start having their first meetings of the season. Catechism and Adult Faith Exploration begin. Students are back at school and university. Holiday travels and vacations are over for the most part, and we get back into a typical routine of work, school, sports, dancing, special clubs, etc.

The thing that we look forward to in particular is the Sunday Liturgy together with our amazing faith family. This experience takes us out of our daily routine and transports us to the very presence of God. We see people that share the same faith as we do, though they may have a very different past from ours, or a very different life situation from ours. How wonderful it is to share who we are with a church-full of like-minded people, and to learn about them! That should be one of our goals this year: to get to know every parishioner a bit better. Who are you? What is your life? Your family? What are (were) your hopes and dreams? What are your needs (*maybe / or we, as a parish family, can help in some way*)? What skills and experience(s) do we have among our parish family members? What can we get started? Something to enhance the life of our parish, or the community around us?

Jesus was all about Evangelization – spreading the Good News and growing the Kingdom of God. What can we do to contribute to this? Maybe the typical things, yes, but BVM Parish has a

unique charism. What can we do in a way that no other group of friends could? Let's think about this, but, especially, let's talk. Maybe we can come down to our auditorium (*sounds better than basement*) for a bit of a chat next Sunday after Liturgy? Let's consider doing that: a brief non-captive get-together. Anyone can leave at any moment (*for Sunday brunch at Baba's or whatever*) but we'll hear or voice a few ideas. Not just the usual suspects. Everyone can express himself. Not just complaints (*those are a dime a dozen*), but realistic visions of hope that we ourselves are willing to help to make happen.

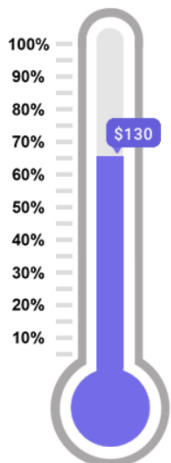
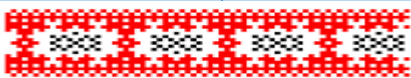

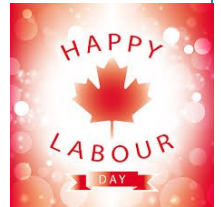
