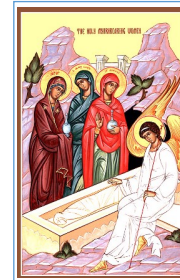

Message for Easter 2024
by Bishop William T. McGrattan,
Bishop of Calgary and President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops

The celebration of Easter is the time when we as Christians renew our baptismal promises. It is through the life-giving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ that we are united with Him. Easter takes us beyond the Cross of sorrow and disappointment to the joy and hope that comes from knowing the Risen Lord. This experience of Christ transformed the disciples. They came to know that His love is for every human person and that the fullness of eternal life is found in Him alone. This is the promise and hope that Easter brings into our lives!

The Risen Lord greeted his disciples, saying: "Peace be to you." In our current world, we must know in faith that the Lord Jesus stands in our midst and says, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you: not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (John 14:27). This must be our heartfelt petition this Easter for many of our brothers and sisters who are experiencing the ongoing tragedy of war and violence.

Easter can also be a time to reflect on our lives of faith and to express the love that our Lord offers to those who live in the shadow of the Cross. It is a love that restores dignity to those who have been exiled from their homes, transforming strangers into neighbours, and calling us to respond with justice, compassion, and care to those who are suffering and who are vulnerable due to the circumstances of their lives. That Easter faith, which allowed the disciples to see not only the tragedy of Jesus death, but also his resurrection, became for them the experience of forgiveness and reconciliation and the beginning of their new life in the risen Christ.

Easter calls us to promote with renewed zeal the witness of our faith by the living testimony of our lives. It calls us to move beyond the tomb of human emptiness by sharing with conviction the good news of the Resurrection. We courageously follow Jesus Christ, the Risen One, and we boldly proclaim that out of the darkness of suffering comes the promise of new life. This Easter, let us rise up with Christ to meet the world and our culture with a renewed conviction to live our faith authentically in serving our brothers and sisters in ways that will bring them hope and joy in Christ.

TWO STORIES that PRAISE GOD'S PRESENCE AMONG US: one in pioneer Saskatchewan, and the other in modern Ukraine:

1) In 1903 and 1904, four brothers – **Nick, John, Julian, and Stanley Korchinski** – left [Ukraine] and arrived in Saskatchewan to homestead adjoining quarter-sections at 18-24-10 W2 near Ituna, northwest of Melville. Their homestead land was five kilometres from the northern section of Little Black Bear Reserve and ten kilometres from the File Hill Reserves.

One of the stories recorded in their family history book describes one summer afternoon in 1907, when John had taken his team of oxen to go rake the hay. In the heat of the day, the untrained oxen began to balk in attempts to pull away from the irritating bites of black flies. At the sudden pull, John was tossed "into the hay rake and was badly cut up." An Indigenous group, likely nêhiyawak and/or Assiniboine/Nakota from Little Black Bear, passed through the area and, upon finding John, "took him to their tents and cared for him for two or three days."



In the book, John's daughters Julia and Dorothea wrote that "John was well cared for; he was unable to speak with the Indians, however he felt they were real brothers." Julia and Dorothea recalled that when their eldest sister, Mary, later married settler Adolph Breden, "many of the neighbouring Indians and Métis attended the wedding and fit in well and enjoyed the merriment." Despite not speaking a common language, the Korchinski homesteading family and their Indigenous neighbours soon developed a close

enough relationship that they attended each others' family gatherings.

2) On January 4, 2023, while in Bakhmut, an extraordinary event occurred.

I was with the soldiers, praying for them and giving out patches with the inscription "God protects and gives victory." Two medics arrived, and I shared the patches with them. One of them asked for a chevron patch with the words "With God Ukraine" so I gave him mine.

They got into the car and stood for a few minutes. Literally two meters from them (25 meters from me), one projectile arrives and after a short time another. Neither exploded! The car in which the medics were sitting was covered with earth from the impact of the projectile. One of the medics gets out of the car and, shaking, approaches me and says: "Chaplain, thank you for being here. God really protects!"

Then he said that he would leave this patch as a certificate of God's protection for his children and grandchildren.

There was another medic 10 meters from the impact point testified that it was God's hand that prevented the projectiles from exploding. All who were witnesses were adamant that it was God who saved them.

Even the most ardent skeptics agree that two shells in a row that did not explode is a miracle.

Brothers, God is alive and He works miracles even today. God is present at the front, and He's there a lot!...

2) 4 січня 2023 р., перебуваючи в Бахмуті, сталася надзвичайна подія:

Спілкуючись з воїнами, молячись за них, давав нашивки з написом "Господь оберігає та дає перемогу". Приїхали два медики, і я поділився з ними нашивками. Один з них попросив шеврон-нашивку зі словами "З Богом Україну" і я віддав йому свою.

Вони сіли в авто і декілька хвилин стояли. Буквально в двох метрах від них (від мене метрів 25) прилітає один снаряд і через короткий час другий. Обидва не розірвались. На авто, в якому сиділи медики, посипались земля від прильоту снаряду. Один з медиків виходить з авто і, трясучись, підходить до мене й говорить: "Капелан, дякую, що ти тут. Бог дійсно захищає".

Потім сказав, що цю нашивку залишить як свідцтво про Божу охорону для своїх дітей та внуків.

Був ще один медик метрів за 10 від прильоту, то він свідчив, що це Божя рука не дозволила розірватись снарядам. Всі, які були свідками, говорять про одне - що це Бог зберіг їх. Навіть самі зяті скептики погоджуються, що два підряд снаряди, які не розірвались, - це чудо.

Брати, Бог живий, і Він робить чудеса і сьогодні Бог присутній на фронті, і Його там багато... sobor.com.ua

«Тримаючись за зачинені на ніч ворота святині, він благав Бога врятувати його смертельно хвору дочку». Папа Франциск нещодавно розповів надзвичайну історію, яка сталася в Аргентині кілька років тому.

Нам невідомо ім'я дівчини, прізвище її батьків чи ім'я священика, який, зворушений виглядом чоловіка, який стоїть на колінах на вулиці вночі, відчинив для нього браму святині. Навіть даючи свідчення Радіо Ватикан про те, що сталося, аргентинський священик вирішив залишитися анонімним, щоб, як він зізнався, промовило саме Євангеліє, яке дивом сповнилося в наш час. Була майже північ. Вулиці Лухана були мертві. Проходячи повз площу, де знаходиться храм, він побачив чоловіка, що стоїть на колінах з букетом троянд у руці. Поруч стояли його друзі, які привезли його за сімдесят кілометрів від столиці, де в лікарні боролася за життя 9-річна дівчинка.

– Санктуарій Богоматері закрили, і він, притулившись до воріт, цілу ніч молився: «Господи, спаси її! Господи, дай їй життя!». Цілу ніч він молився до Матері Божої, взиваючи до Бога, волаючи від серця.

Того дня Церква читала історію з Євангелія про сліпого Вартимея, наполегливе благання якого почув Ісус, що проходив поруч. Папа нагадав, що «коли віра жива, молитва щира: вона не просить копійки. Ісус може все, ти повинен просити про все. Він з нетерпінням очікує вилити Свою благодать і радість у наші серця. Але, на жаль, ми тримаємося осторонь, можливо, через сором'язливість, лінч чи невіру». Папа Франциск додав, що багато хто з нас, коли молившись, не вірять, що Господь може творити чудеса. Інакше було з відчайдушним батьком.

Марія явила чудо -- Священик зупинився біля чоловіка, що стояв на колінах, і запитав, що трапилося. Почувши, що його донька бореться за життя в лікарні, провів його через бічний вхід до санктуарію Непорочного Зачаття Богоматері. Охорона була здивована, але не заважала.

Чоловік поклав квіти перед вітарем. Він весь час стояв на колінах, поки я вголос молився на вервиці за його маленьку доньку. Наприкінці я дав йому своє благословення і ми попрощалися, – згадує священик, який розповів Папі про цю подію.

Через кілька тижнів в храм зайшов усміхнений чоловік з милою блондинкою на руках. Він запитав мене, чи я впізнав його. Побачивши моє здивоване обличчя, він сказав, що він той чоловік, з яким я молився вночі, а на руках тримав доньку, яку чудово зцілила Марія, – розповідає священик, додаючи, що вони більше ніколи не зустрічалися.

Коли чоловік штурмував небо, лікарі з подиву протирали очі. Опівночі дівчина прокинулася, сіла в ліжку і, як ні в чому не була, сказала матері, що голодна. Її стан швидко покращувався – Коли вранці чоловік повернувся до лікарні, то виявив дружину, яка плакала. Він думав, що його дочка померла. А тим часом дружина розповіла йому, що сталося щось незрозуміле, чого лікарі не можуть пояснити. Здавалося, їхня дівчинка одужала. Це диво підтвердилося і наступними днями, коли дівчина вийшла з інтенсивної терапії і повна сил виписалася з лікарні.

Бог діє тут і зараз -- Аргентинський священик додає, що був свідком багатьох чудес, які виливалися через заступництво Богоматері з Лухана. – Євангеліє здійснюється в сучасних подіях. Боже Слово наголошує, що наполеглива й мужня молитва справді відкриває небо. Розповідаючи цю історію, папа Франциск захоплювався до сміливості в молитві. «Нехай Мати Божо, Діва молитви, навчить нас звертатися до Бога всім серцем». Папа також попросив аргентинського священика задокументувати чудеса, які відбуваються в Лухані. Книга про подвиги молитви вже пишеться. *Олексій Погорелов, rodyna.org.ua*

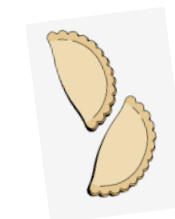

She was the First Person to Kiss Elvis On-Screen... and then Became a Nun



Actress **Dolores Hart**, who was once hailed as the next Grace Kelly, gave Elvis Presley his first on-screen kiss and worked alongside leading men like Montgomery Clift, Anthony Quinn and Marlon Brando -- just to name a few. But in 1962 she left Hollywood behind and became a nun.

In 2016, the former star, now known as Mother Dolores Hart, celebrated 50 years of vowed life at the Abbey of Regina Laudis, an enclosed Benedictine monastery and working farm in Bethlehem, Conn. **The [now-85-year-old]** previously released a memoir titled "The Ear of the Heart: An Actress' Journey from Hollywood to Holy Vows," where she detailed her surprising journey.

Her story was also the subject of an Oscar-nominated short film on HBO, titled "**God Is the Bigger Elvis**," released in 2012. Today, Hart receives hundreds of letters from people across the country seeking guidance on having a closer relationship with God.



Fox News: What was your initial impression of Elvis Presley?

Mother Dolores Hart: To be honest, I did not know who he was. In fact, when I first met him, I asked him what he did. I remember him being very courteous. He was an absolute gentleman and would call me "Miss Dolores." And then I learned what a talented singer he was. By the time we did our second film, we couldn't walk down the street because there were so many people waiting for him, just wanting to touch him. I remember one moment when we were taking a break from filming. He walked over to me, handed me a Bible, and said, "Miss Dolores, would you open this book? What do you see? What does it mean to you?" And so, I offered my opinion on what I was seeing. And from there, we spent the time in between the scenes talking about the Bible. I never expected a fellow actor, in particular, to have that kind of genuine curiosity. He wasn't trying to set up anything. There were no flashbulbs around to take pictures of us. He did it because it was in his heart. *[When asked about that first kiss, she just smiles and says that their ears had to have extra make-up applied because they turned so red.]*

Fox News: How did you discover the Abbey of Regina Laudis?

Mother Hart: I was actually doing a show at the time, but the demands of the stage really became exhausting. It was a friend who suggested that I should take a few days to rest at the Abbey of Regina Laudis... I wasn't expecting just how peaceful it truly was. I found inner certitude. I felt like this is where I belonged. It became more than just a retreat. It's the kind of feeling you get when you meet the person you're going to marry. The more I came to visit the more it came calling to me. And the more I knew God was present to me in a very special way that I couldn't deny.

Fox News: You were engaged to Don Robinson. Where did you find the courage to walk away and embark on the journey you're in now?

Mother Hart: You're right, Don and I were engaged. I had a concern that somehow I wasn't sure [about the engagement]... He was a beautiful guy and a real gentleman too. He was also an architect and built houses. I remembered as soon as he asked me to marry him, he found the place that he wanted us to live. I said, "Don, we're going too fast... I remember I was on a lunch date with Don. That's when I said, "Don, I just have to tell you. I cannot say yes to this." He stood up from the table and yelled "No!" And of course, everyone at the restaurant looked at us. I looked at him and said, "Don, I'm telling you the truth. I really love you, but not in the way that you want." Then I told him what I really wanted to do with my life. God was calling me and I felt it in my heart that I needed to answer. He then looked at me and said, "I've known it. I know this is what you want. I'm going to help you. I promise you that I will." The first year I entered the Abbey, Don went to Hawaii. I thought, "Well, that's goodbye. I will never hear from him again." I was wrong. Don came to visit me. And up until the day he died [in 2011] he came to the Abbey at least once a year to help in any way he could, to work in areas that would be acceptable. And he never married. I remember he once told me, "Every love doesn't have to wind up at the altar." I believe Don is now with the Lord. " *(from foxnews.com 2021)*
