Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven! Благословенний, хто йде у Господнє Ім'я! Осанна на висоті!

Today we, too, hold high our branches like the people of Jerusalem and, like them, we cannot contain ourselves, but we must shout "Hosannah" with unbridled joy! Why? Because, salvation is so near



now! Our salvation and redemption and the resurrection is now so near! Our Ukrainian folk tradition, we would swat (tap) a friend or family member saying, "Не я б'ю, верба б'є, за тиждень Великдень!; Будь великий, як верба, а здоровий, як вода, а багатий, як земля!" "I don't strike you, the willow branch strikes you, in a week it will be Easter!". It's kind of like a wake-up call or an encouragement not to become drowsy or lazy now, but stay the course! Keep with the spiritual and penitential program of Lent the Great Fast. As we will soon arrive at a joy that by far surpasses that of the Messiah entering the holy city! Now we enter that mystical adventure of Passion Week. In the next couple of days, everything take an unexpected turn... a downward spiral into unthinkable darkness. Even Jesus' closest followers will fall into fear and confusion. Will we... stand among the crowd that will change our shout from "Hosannah" to "Crucify Him!"? How could that be possible? Will we choose sin and the world and power and prestige instead of sticking with the small group of a few women and a young man who will stay with Jesus all the way through Passion Week and eventually stand, at the foot of the Cross - come what may?! Dare to stay with Jesus as much as possible this Holy Week... there will be services, but also times to set up and take down, time to help (if help is needed) or just to sit in a corner of our vast church contemplate our relationship with God and, as the Apostle Paul says, "work out our own salvation with fear and trembling" (Philippians 2:12) before the Lord comes again, soon, in glory!
