Today, of course, is our 2023 Annual Parish Meeting (AGM). It is the first such meeting of our new second century into which we cautiously, but joyfully march as a parish family on "a mission from God" no less! It is an opportunity to pause and reflect on what direction we really need to take to fully serve our Lord and our Neighbour! The AGM begins after our ← snowman fellowship!

The coffee and fellowship is also a commitment (albeit a very easy and tasty one!) it gives us a great opportunity to just come together, get to know each other better and just to talk about as profound or superficial things as we like. But enjoy the company of our true brothers and sisters (and aunts and uncles?) in Christ! Our fellow journeyers through this life!

We are honoured to host a sad, yet proud, prayer commending the souls of two representatives of the thousands of people who have decided to stand their ground in Ukraine and defend freedom and identity and truth. As well as praying for them and all our brothers and sisters in Ukraine during the Divine Liturgy, as we do every day since the Russia invaded Ukraine, we will pray a Panakhyda immediately after the Eucharistic liturgy. Please, do stay and participate.

Today is also the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee. The Gospel reading will give us a lot of food for thought in itself. However, this Sunday also signals to us that the Great Fast - i.e. Lent - is soon approaching. Soon to follow are the Sundays of the "Prodigal

(repentance and forgiveness), Son" "Meatfare" (final judgement, accountability for how we spend the gift of life); and "Cheesefare" (living a real Christian life). We start to psych ourselves up for the amazing time of intensified prayer, fasting and charity that are the hallmarks of Lent. In preparation we do have some benefits - like this coming Friday is not a fast or abstinence day (so pull out the BBQ if you like). It is often the custom of our people to have Pushchennya a sort of Mardi gras before the 40-day fasting period. Let's keep our life real by living life and doing the great things to which our God calls us - Fr Michael day by day!

Sanctuary Lamp/Вічна Лямпа: Christ God, present in the Blessed Sacrament, guide us in the weeks after our AGM

Christ Icon – Christ, teach us to discern truth in our news in our conversations in the promises of our politicians



Mother of God Icon - Mother Mary, please protect the vulnerable who are mercilessly abused by evil people, comfort those who were and reveal to us how we can help.

Request your Vigil Lamp intention at least a week ahead of time. What a beautiful way of praying, knowing the candle burns for a week for your intention.

This Thursday is the Feast of the Encounter or Presentation of the infant Jesus in the temple. It is a major feast of the year and we must all try to get to church this day. We will have two Divine Liturgies so that those who can't come in the morning can make it in the evening. (or, if neither of these times are good for you, please make it to another church that has Liturgy at a time that works for your work/school/care-providing schedule. On this feast we also bless candles! In obedience to the Old Law, the Lord Jesus, the first born, was presented in the Temple on the fortieth day after His birth. a holy old man, Simeon was promised by the Lord that he would not see death before seeing the Messiah. When he took Jesus into his arms, he declared, "Lord, now let Your servant depart in peace, according to Your word; for my eyes have seen Your salvation, which You have prepared before the face of all people, a light of revelation to the gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel"

By our prayers we commend to her loving Lord the soul of the servant of God Stephaie Demkiw, who was buried at the Presbyterian Cemetery north of Chief Peguis Trail this past Friday. It was a "feels like -26" snow-blowing morning, and few people gathered. Korban Funeral Service personnel and cemetery workers were kind enough to perform their duties and participate in the brief panakhyda prayers led by our Pastor Fr. Michael. In the early years and even centuries of the Church, followers of Christ were

persecuted by non-Christians and those that lost their Christian faith. This, of course has been the case at different time in various places throughout the world... up to our day. Well, Christians, want to know each other and so they developed different signs and symbols that would make it easy for those who "got it", but wouldn't endanger them from those who wouldn't understand. One such simple symbol was fish! (you've seen them on the back of

cars as you drive, like the one in the top left corner). Why a fish!? Well the fiveletter Greek word for fish

was **ΙΧΘΥΣ**. (pronounced IXT/IC or IKhThYS). The Christians made an acronym (or acrostic) out of the letters: I for lesous (Jesus), X for Khristos (Christ), **O** for Theos (God) **Y** for Yios (Son) and **Σ** for Sotyr (Saviour). Pretty clever, eh? So if you saw the fish symbol on the wall in someone's home or in some other place, it was a good chance that you had come into contact with a fellow Christian. What English or Ukrainian "secret" symbol or acrostic/acronym could you come up with that we could use to designate our parish?
