### ONE WEEK! ЩЕ ОДИН ТИЖДЕНЬ!

One week away from our major centenary event ...and today we hear a Gospel message from the Lord that speaks to what we are about to commemorate next week!

Our parish, similar to what happened on the shore of Lake Genesareth, started off with a few people who heard an internal voice of the Lord encouraging them to go out into deep water, where a Ukrainian Catholic Parish did not exist (and who knew if it would take) and cast out their nets and see what happened. They did so, cautiously but courageously, and filled with faith. They never looked back. The Lord remained with them and many others joined them. The successor to the Apostles - Bishop Mykyta Budka - blessed their beginnings as did his successors throughout 100 years! So many blessings did God's People receive through Blessed Virgin Mary Parish! So many Baptisms and Chrismations! So many Marriages and family beginnings! Yes, also we have had a number of vocations born in our parish or developed here - priests,

religious sisters, deacons. Yes, there were many funerals also where good people of faith enjoyed the blessing of a proper Christian burial (denied to so many, it seems, in our day). So many truly countless moments of joy and comfort and internal grace experienced by the thousands of individuals who have prayed in our parish churches - even if it was a passing experience by witnessing a wedding or a funeral or some other event that they attended by chance.

When we encounter Christ in the fullness of His Presence - like those who have the grace to attend a Divine Liturgy and truly be in the PRESENCE OF GOD through the Holy Eucharist - we have feelings of joy and peace, and perhaps, like St Peter, a sense of our unworthiness. Actually, we should have all those feelings all together! We really are unworthy, and the older we get and more mature in our faith, we will understand that unworthiness ever more acutely. However, we have every reason to be awestruck and thrilled when we also understand that our God is present to us as we enter our BVM church. He is present in the most holy Sacrament reserved on the Altar - for those who are sick, but especially for our Adoration. We receive our Lord and God when we dare receive Holy Communion.

People have been doing this for the past century at our Parish. This in itself is a reason to rejoice... along with so many other reasons! So, let's get ready to take this all in and contemplate it and celebrate it next Sunday at 3:00 PM!

Ours is a big church, but be sure to get here early for a good seat!

**Three great Confession stories:**

**"Every year I go to Lourdes, and when I'm in Lourdes I always go to Confession.** There are all these little rooms, each one has a priest in it, and a little sign outside with what languages are available. The English queue was long, but right opposite were the Spanish confessionals and there was no-one there, so I decided to confess in Spanish which I have done before. The priest was really nice and I told him about a lot of issues I was having with my family and especially with my mum. The following year I went back to Lourdes and when I went to Confession the same Spanish priest was there and I went to him again. After I had finished confessing, he said, "You were here last year I think?" and I said I was and he said, "How is your mother? I have been praying for her all year." And I thought, **if this is the fidelity of one priest to a woman he doesn't know, how much greater must the love and fidelity of God be!** I don't need to stress so much about this because God is totally going care of me and my family!" **"One powerful confession I was not part of but witnessed.** Before my best friend's wedding, two priests were going to hear confessions for the wedding party and family. One had just been ordained the day before! Before hearing confessions the two priests went into the "cry room" and sat down across from each other, with one hearing the other's confession. The room had a window that the rest of us waiting for confession could see through. After the one priest received absolution, the other one took his stole off and put it over the first priest's shoulders and confessed to him. It was a powerful image to me of the one priesthood of Christ: it is not the priest who absolves, but Christ, whose priestly office is signified by the stole." Ryan Mayer

**"A lot of people don't like tough confessors, but I purposefully seek them out** because I like being held more accountable in confession. This guy actually treats all sins, even the small ones, seriously. I remember confessing some small slip of chastity despite being a very chaste person and he gave me a little lecture on how chaste people don't fall all at once, they fall little by little, and I need to nip it in the bud immediately. Other priests I've confessed to would totally brush something like that off, but he took it very seriously and gave me a pretty tough penance designed to help me get back on the right track with it. It felt like he actually cared about helping me become holy." Anon

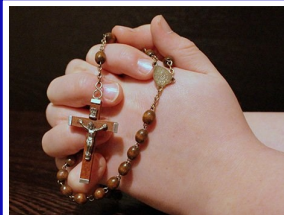

If you can check off all the above, talk to a priest you trust TODAY.
