2. Please come downstairs today right after Divine Liturgy to discuss recent ideas and to plan for a successful **100th anniversary** of our parish. Two Sundays ago we had great input. We hope you have read some of the ideas that were placed in a special insert in this bulletin, so come down at least to "hear what the talk is".

3. We have been doing Pylypiwka readings immediately after each Divine Liturgy. Please stay, after having attended or tuned into the liturgy. Let's meditate and pray as a parish family in preparation for Christmas. THE BOOKS ARE READY -- please pick up your free copy at the back of the church!

4. We want to put together another special video this year of carols, poems, instrumental pieces (maybe even a vertep!?), to post on Youtube and Facebook. Blessed Virgin Mary parish has an amazing amount of talent. Call the office this week and say what you would do as a 1-2 min. performance! and if you are asked to do or help out with something, please do the opposite of what you should do when offered drugs (or anything sinful for that matter), and "JUST SAY YES!"

5. Because of the size of our church, no preregistration is actually required for regular liturgical services. We do, however, want some record of participants if, God forbid, there is a need to contact everyone. Furthermore, to be absolutely sure that you have a spot (just incase our church nears its capacity on Sundays or Feastdays), you may register in advance by email. 6. Catechism -- Classes continue on Sunday and Tuesday nights, under the direction of Theresa Stojanowicz Hryndzio (204-334-4298. Please call to enroll your child AND to volunteer to offer Catechism

7. Just a reminder that during the pandemic, our parish is willing to host events - *at least for our parishioners* - but there are particular requirements. The church and the auditorium need to be cleaned after events where *large* numbers of people gather. So... **cleaners** come in Monday (*i.e. following Sunday* services) and after larger events (e.g. funerals). This means that, for a **funeral**, for example, besides the regular fees [\$350 clergy; \$100 cantor(s); as well as \$100 for church cleaning. And, if applicable, \$125 for auditorium "rental", as well as \$50 for auditorium cleaning].
