Слава Icycy Христу! Christ's love for us.... Redemptorist Priest, Fr. Michael Schudlo, CSsR, in his now legendary prayerbook "My Divine Friend", wrote about the feast of "Christ the Lover of Mankind" that we transferred from Friday to this Sunday.... "Venerable Pope Pius XII says, 'Devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is essentially devotion to the love

with which God loved us through Jesus and is at the same time a revitalizing of our love for God and man'. It is therefore the most excellent form of religion, because it renders honour and homage to the eternal love of God for us. Christ became man, because He loved us, He lives in the Blessed Sacrament because He loves us, and He is utterly patient with us, because He loves us. A person's heart is a longstanding symbol of our love. Christ's heart is regarded as the source of His love for us. No wonder that we honour Jesus' Heart as a wonderful symbol of Christ's love for us!" (adapted from

page 398). ... and Fathers Day... This feast of Christ's love for us also has a great Father connection. Why did Jesus Christ the "Son of the living God" the "Second person of the Holy Trinity" do all He did for us!? Very simply and clearly, He did it



(and continues to do it) because of His love for God the Father! The love that energizes God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit is that love that motivated God to send His only *unbegotten* Son to us and for the Son (*Jesus*) to willingly be born into the world to fulfil the Father's plan of Salvation. Jesus told us this on several occasions. "God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son" (*Jn* 3:16) "so that the world may know that I love the Father, I do exactly as the Father commanded me" (*Jn* 14:31); "I and the Father are one" (*Jn* 10:30). The dedicated, sincere love of a father inspires his children to show that same love in life toward God, and all one's family members and neighbours. "God is Love!" *Fr. Michael*

# Another View: Why We Celebrate Every Year the Feast of Christ, the Lover of Mankind

In the mid-1850s, the people of the Caucasus Mountains in south Russia were ruled by a very just sultan, Schlamyl, who wished to clean out corruption and bribery from his people. He made a law that whoever was convicted of bribery should be punished by fifty blows of the whip in sight of all the people.

An astonishing thing happened: The first one to be caught in bribery was the sultan's mother! The news hurt him terribly. For three days he struggled with himself in his tent. On the fourth day he appeared before the people, had his mother brought before them, and gave orders to two men to begin the whipping. But just as the first blow was about to fall, he suddenly pushed to his mother's side, untied her hands, and gave orders to his two men to tie his hands instead. to tear his shirt from his shoulders and to begin the whipping. They did so, unwillingly. With a deathly pale face, he bore all fifty blows himself till the blood began to flow from his wounds. Then he turned to his shocked people and said, "Now you may go to your homes. The law has been satisfied; the blood of your sultan has flowed to make up for this crime." And from that day bribery was never heard of again, because the people never forgot their just ruler Schlamyl.

Never forget what our redemption cost Jesus, who Himself accepted the falling blows of God's just anger and took our punishment in our stead. He also could say to His heavenly Father: "Accept these sinners as Your children again, for the Blood of Your own Son has flowed on Calvary to make up for their sins." (Father L. Lovasik)

PHYSICAL WORKOUTS -- and SPIRITUAL!

Sports-minded and active-living enthusiasts are absolutely right, with regard to the body: IF WE DO EXERCISES and WORK-OUTS, we'll feel better and stay healthier!

Well, the same goes for spiritual life. Here's what a very active young lady named Jaquie tells us about her morning routine. We have to "follow the rules:



1. Prepare for exertion. We come to Mass not as spectators but as participants. Prepare to join with other members of the Body of Christ in prayer, worship & thanksgiving.

2. Stretch out. Is something holding you back from giving your whole love, attention to Eternal God? If you are carrying worry, anger. resentment, guilt... spend a few moments letting it go! <u>3. Start slowly</u>. Arrive early to review the readings. Ask what Eternal God is trying to tell you personally In the words of Scripture.

<u>4. Get into the Zone</u>. Something amazing happens every moment during the Divine Liturgy. Don't miss a single one! Think about what you are saying as you recite the prayers. Enthusiastically speak the responses. Sing with your whole heart. Allow yourself to be awed by receiving the precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

5. Cool down. After the celebrant leaves the Church, spend a few moments figuring out what Eternal God wants you to do for the next week as a result of what you just heard and said.
