СЛАВА ІСУСУ ХРИСТУ! All SAINTS OF UKRAINE

Today we celebrate **All the Saints of Ukraine** who have been recognized throughout history... not only since Ukraine's 'official' acceptance of Christianity by the efforts of Grand Prince **St. Volodymyr the Great** in 988, but since the days of the Apostolic Church when, as legend has it, the holy **Apostle Andrew** travelled through and placed a cross on the bank of the Dnipro river at what is now the city of Kyiv with its many magnificent golden-domed churches and monasteries. We include also the holy men and women who, although they did not originate from the land of Ukraine, are closely tied to it: like Pope **St. Clement I** who died a martyr at Khersones, Crimea in the year 97 AD. [*Patriarch Joseph Slipyj*, himself now a candidate for sainthood, named the first Ukrainian Catholic University in Rome in honour of this St. Clement]. We have printed a large list of the many celebrated Ukrainian saints in past bulletins on the occasion of this feast. This year, we would like to focus on those who were declared "Blessed" by Pope St. John Paul II in 2001, because todays feast and the feast of the New martyrs (June 27) almost coincide this year.

Several icons have been written to commemorate the "new Blesseds" as they are sometimes referred to. Some of the icons depict only those who were martyrs, while others contain only those who were members of the Ukrainian (Greco-) Catholic Church *per se*. Well, during his historic visit to Ukraine in 2001, Pope John Paul II actually beatified 30 people. Most were from the Ukrainian Catholic, but some also of the Russian Catholic and Roman Catholic, Churches. Most were **martyrs**, but three were not. Most were victims of **Communist** persecution, but one - Blessed

Omelian Kowch - died in a NAZI **fascist** concentration camp. In our picture here, we added **Blessed Josaphata** who was not a martyr, but she is obviously very well known to us as she was the co-foundress of the Sisters who operate **Immaculate Heart School** and **Holy Family Home**. Blessed **Vasyl' Velychkovsky** (whose

shrine we have right here in Winnipeg) stand at the front of this group of martyrs along with another Redemptorist bishop, Blessed **Nicholas Charnetsky**. Can you name them all? Do you know their stories? They were martyrs in *our* day and certainly that of our parents and grandparents...

This week! Do not miss the special June 27-27 events at the Blessed Vasyl Martyr's Shrine, that is in our own city, and in our own North End! Millions around the world would love to be able to visit this shrine dedicated to one of the Church's real authentic Martyrs and to pray before the holy relics that are enshrined there! This is amazing! A unique opportunity to flood your life and that of your marriage and family with God's grace.



Only you can stop it from going bust. Many appreciate you, admire you and love you. But remember that to be happy is not to have a sky without a storm, a road without accidents, work without fatigue, relationships without disappointments. To be happy is to find strength in forgiveness, hope in battles, security in the stage of fear, love in discord. It is not only to enjoy the smile, but also to reflect on the sadness. It is not only to celebrate the successes, but to learn lessons from the failures. It is not only to feel happy with the applause, but to be happy in anonymity. Being happy is not a fatality of destiny, but an achievement for those who can travel within themselves. To be happy is to stop feeling like a victim and become your destiny's author. It is to cross deserts, yet to be able to find an oasis in the depths of our soul. It is to thank God for every morning, for the miracle of life. Being happy is not being afraid of your own feelings. It's to be able to talk about you. It is having the courage to hear a "no". It is confidence in the face of criticism, even when unjustified. It is to kiss your children, pamper your parents, to live poetic moments with friends, even when they hurts. To be happy is to let live the creature that lives in each of us, free, joyful and simple. It is to have maturity to be able to say: "I made mistakes". It is to have the courage to say "I am sorry". It is to have the sensitivity to say, "I need you". It is to have the ability to say "I love you". May your life become a garden of opportunities for happiness ... That in spring may it be a lover of joy. In winter a lover of wisdom. And when you make a mistake, start all over again. For only then will you be in love with life. You will find that to be happy is not to have a perfect life. But use the tears to irrigate tolerance. Use your losses to train patience. Use your mistakes to sculpture serenity. Use pain to plaster pleasure. Use obstacles to open windows of intelligence.
