This is "Mother's Day"! It has a long history of becoming the special day that it is today throughout (most of) the world. Eventually most modern countries - like Ukraine 24 years ago - declared "Mother's Day" as a national commemoration. So today we wholeheartedly join our collective parish voice in honouring each and every one of our mothers! And we should!... both from the depths of our hearts and as a proclamation! Like a number of other bizarre social trends in the last few years, the unthinkable is being proposed that "Mother's Day" be downplayed or even eliminated.

What? How? Why?

Motherhood has been chipped away at and compromised in not a few ways over the last decades. First of all, the very honour and warmth that mothers arouse in our hearts has been challenged for some

encouraged or even demanded that mothers needed to find a way to raise their children and work a full job at the same time. This led mothers to near exhaustion or deciding to entrust their children to grandparents or nurseries or day care. Or creating the concept of "latchkey kids". Not because they didn't want to be with their children as they grew up, but because they felt compelled to provide for their material needs. Some families were able to or decided to do with less so that the mother could be what became known as a "stayat-home" mother. We won't even get into the unconscionable proposal of society that mothers can choose to curtail their plans of a large family or even to terminate if they have already conceived their child!

Then, on the other

spectrum of life, society is moving us to forget the many years of 200% dedication on the part of mothers who raise us. The thought now is 'Forget about spending time reciprocating parents' love by seeing to it that they are at least adequately taken care of until the Lord calls them home (Ephesians 6:1-4). Instead, place them in places where they can be forgotten [not all such places are bad - if we maintain a "hands on" interest and visit frequently with love and carel or, most recently, maybe the best way for your mother and for you - is an early exit by "medical" assistance.

No! As Christians who have been called out of this worldly culture, that is not our way. We not only see the great love and dedication that our own mothers have shown us in the best way they knew how at the time, we see the great value and need for a strong motherhood in society. Whether our mothers are still with us or if they have gone from this life to prepare a place for us in the next life, today we proclaim I love you Mom! and God bless our Mothers and all mothers throughout this world! 
