Dear Friends:

How good it is to be back home after a whirlwind trip to Rome and Ukraine and a few stops in between. When I arrived home late this past week I got in a bit of a sleep, then one of the warm joys was being able to pray the next morning with the parishioners who could make it and just give glory to God and in familiar surroundings. Perhaps that is my first commercial plug of this bulletin: Let us open our minds and hearts to appreciate the wonderful church and parish that we have. What a place of beauty and good people where

we are truly welcome and should feel at home!

When in Rome, I had my first experience at a Synod of Bishops of our Ukrainian Catholic Church. Three things that became obvious from the beginning were: 1. The work of the synod and the program of operation is very high-level. Everything is so well prepared and presented. The discussions and eventual voting were efficiently run where everyone had a say. The program was intense from morning to night so that at the end of the day, one was ready for a good rest. 2. The second thing that was obvious was how much the bishops cared for the wellbeing of their people. The Bishops from Ukraine especially emotionally spoke about their people and how they were suffering or in peril, and they wanted to do everything possible to help them and alleviate their suffering. This was a concern about their physical and emotional wellbeing, but also especially spiritual. In fact, the theme of next year's Synod will EVEN tHE dOGS Eat tHE CRUMBS that fall FROM THEIR MOSTER'S TODIE.



be about Evangelization and Catechesis in time of war and the aftermath. Then, 3. I couldn't help but notice the brotherhood among the Bishops. They collaborated so well together even though, as would be expected, there was a bishop of every type of character and background, from eparchies all around the world.

I made it to **Ukraine**, where I enjoyed getting a lot done and was able to meet with a lot of people that I



have known through the chancery, the university and through life in the church there. The reality of war came through daily as I met soldiers on leave from the front and experienced three nights of rocket sirens while there. One drone rocket did strike Lviv while I was there, killing one man, injuring another (he lost his leg) and destroying three depots housing some 300 tons of humanitarian food and aid. Everyone spoke of his experiences. Everyone prays and hopes for the war to end. Please keep them all in your prayer.

There were so many unexpected highlights in addition to the main purposes for the trip. One was traveling with the Bishop of the occupied city of Donetsk VI. Stefan Meniok, CSsR from the Synod to Ukraine. Another was stepping in to see Sr. Margaretta in Krakow. Sister is bedridden, but fondly remembers BVM Parish and was happy with the brief visit.

Now we prepare for a joyful Parish Praznyk next Sunday. Let's make it a day of happiness and grace!
