СЛАВА ІСУСУ ХРИСТУ! **GLORY TO JESUS CHRIST!**

Dear Friends,

They say honey, not vinegar catches more flies (per St. Anselm). But what if you offer delicacies galore at a wonderful banquet... and everyone you invite decides to stay away?

A King had organized a wonderful banquet, but nearly everyone who had been invited, demurred. Imagine that. They said they would come, but then they changed their minds, and decided not to bother!

In the Middle East, when you are invited, it is done far in advance, and it's a given that you or someone in your family will attend, for to say "no" is an insult. The invitees probably said "yes" at first, but closer to the date, they showed their true disdain for the event by choosing other things as more important. Today, here in our city of Winnipeg, the excuses would be: "Sorry, I'm moving into another apartment that day." "Sorry, I have to get to Costco... to Ikea... because that's the only day I have free..." "Sorry, my grandkids are coming over... "Sorry, it's the last chance we have to get out to the cottage that weekend...'

The King is furious, but he is determined to go on with the banquet, and he orders his men to go out and collect anyone, even the homeless and the "deplorables". The music starts up merrily, food is enjoyed by all... and then in saunters a man who looks around, maybe nibbles at this, nibbles at that... has a good toss of the wine... and then the King sees him. His fury rekindles ... but wait... since He is a gentleman, He merely asks at first, through whited lips:

'My friend,' he said, 'how is it you came in here not properly dressed?'

In those days, in those areas, you were handed a garment to put over your clothing. There was no excuse not to be wearing one inside the banquet compound. To have walked in, bypassing the offering at the door of the wedding garment, was pretty much akin to a slap in the face to the King.

But this man dares to remain silent! He just doesn't care! He expects to continue eating and drinking with the others, even though he has done nothing to respect the occasion.

What an ignorant man that must have been. Perhaps even a malicious one. But my friends, that man without the wedding garment is you. It is I.

How dare we presume to saunter into heaven, to live with the King of Kings, without a wedding garment? But so many of us are doing just that. We think we can do just that.

We were given the garment at our Baptism. We were supposed to keep it clean and white, and then have it on in order to enter Heaven. If we tore it, dirtied it (by sin), we could easily launder it by going to confession. But so many of us don't bother. We were supposed to attend Divine Liturgy on Sundays (at the very least) as the earthly practice for attending the Heavenly Banquet... but so many of us don't bother. Our children have fallen away... gone to other churches... (maybe not even there)... been "married" by "marriage commissioners"... Gone seems to be the effort the early Church Fathers encouraged: that we strive to become holy (by loving and keeping God's 10 Commandments and the directives of our Catholic Church) and once we are holy, we should strive to become holier!

Our whole purpose on this earth is to know, love and serve God, so that we can be happy with Him in Heaven. We do this by accepting the wedding garment at our baptism, with our godparents as proxies, and keeping it as clean as we can by trying to live a truly Christian life. Only then may we hope to join the King of Kings at His glorious heavenly We have great problems in these 2020s: wars (most notably Russia/Ukraine), epidemics and pandemics, terrifying fires and hurricanes worldwide. Our churches should be filled. They are not. How are we and our families any better than the man who at least sauntered into the banquet?

Note what happens to him at the end of the story. The King doesn't say, "Oh well, let's just enjoy people as they are... let's just "accompany them" as they walk about and maybe some day they'll understand why My banquet is so important." No. The King gives orders for the man to be "bound hand and foot, and thrown out into the night where there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth". Why? **Because that man knew better. His parents taught him better.** Our parents and grandparents taught us better... but so many of us choose to just put it to the side. And the rest of the people, the ones who didn't even bother coming? Well, "many are called, but few are chosen." Chosen, that is, to enter
