Glory to Jesus Christ! Слава Ісусу Христу!


Our parish may be more active than you think... in our prayer life. We have DAILY prayer beginning at 7:20 every weekday morning. And our prayer on Sundays begins at 9:20 am. At those times we pray one of the **Hours** of Divine Office [a practice from the time of Christ] and then a Rosary [that Our Lady at Fatima asked us to pray daily for Peace and the conversion of those obstinate in sin and for the deceased] and the Divine Liturgy. The Divine Liturgy is that amazing miracle by which we are united to Jesus Christ the Son of God through Holy Communion. We also have Vespers on Saturday evenings and, until the end of the year of Saint Joseph we have a Tuesday evening devotion to St. Joseph. We will surely be adding at least one other Sunday Divine Liturgy when we can discern the best time. If we wonder of the timing of the services is too early or too late... we are starting from the wrong premise. The first point is... "I can be with the living God at those time!? These services are open to me!? I can actually encounter the living Jesus Christ and be together with the saints and all the people of God in a mystical, yet real and powerful way!? Where else would I rather be!? No really. Where else would I rather be?

An update to our Archeparchial Covid19 Directives has been issued. Much remains as it was where our 'Parish event' numbers remain at a good (33%) capacity. This means Liturgies, prayer services, organization events, Catechism, etc.

more The cautionary restriction of 25 participants (plus essential staff) remains in place for Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals. It is unfortunate that the "church aspect" is not treated separately from the celebratory/social reception, since the blessing of a marriage or a baptism or a funeral of one of our parishioners is also really a 'parish event' (although the reception after such an event is understandably by invitation only). However, the reasoning for a heavier restriction on such events is that often enough people also travel from outside the parish to attend and perhaps emotions cause people to forget about safety precautions, etc.

The Directives do offer a possible option of more persons if it seems necessary and if the family or organizers request it. We could talk about how this could happen. However, the primary spirit of our parish is to be open to all, regardless of what *credentials* they may carry or their ability to attend. This is why we are also grateful that we have been blessed with very good LIVESTREAMING available for all events.

Again, this does not affect our Sunday or other Divine Liturgies... as, thanks to the foresight of past generation(s), our church is quite spacious...
