



Апостол: До Римлян послання святого апостола Павла читання (10:1-10)

Браття і Сестри! Бажання мого серця і моя молитва до Бога за Ізраїля, щоб вони спаслися. Я бо їм свідчу, що вони мають ревність Божу, та вона не розумна. Не розуміючи Божої справедливости й шукаючи установити свою власну, вони не покорилися справедливості Божій. Бо мета закону -- Христос, на оправдання кожного, хто вірує. Мойсей про праведність, що від закону, пише: "Той, хто його виконує, буде ним жити." А про справедливість, що від віри, так говорить: "Не кажи у твоїм серці: хто зійде на небо?" -тобто: Христа звести додолу; або: хто зійде в безодню? -- тобто:

щоб вивести Христа з мертвих. Що отже, вона каже? "Близько тебе слово: в твоїх устах і в твоїм серці", тобто слово віри, що його проповідуємо. Бо коли ти твоїми устами визнаватимеш Господа Ісуса і віруватимеш у твоїм серці, що Бог воскресив його з мертвих, то спасешся, бо серцем вірується на оправдання, а устами визнається на спасіння. Стихи на Алилуя: Натягни лук і наступай, і пануй істини ради, лагідности і справедливости.

Ти полюбив правду і зненавидів беззаконня.

#### **Євангелія:** Від Матея 8: 28 - 9: 1

Одного разу, коли Ісус прибув на той бік, у край гадаринський, зустріли його два біснуваті, що вийшли з гробів, такі люті, що ніхто не міг перейти тією дорогою. І стали кричати: "Що нам і тобі, Сину Божий? Прийшов єси сюди, щоб нас мучити перед часом? "Поблизу же від них паслося велике стадо свиней. Біси попросили його: "Як ти нас виганяєщ; пошли нас в оте стадо свиней." "Ідіть!" сказав їм. І вийшли з них, і ввійшли у свиней. Тоді все стадо кинулося з кручі в море і втопилось у хвилях. А пастухи втекли і, прибігши в місто, все розповіли, про біснуватих. І ось усе місто вийшло Ісусові назустріч, і, побачивши його, попросили, щоб відійшов з їхніх околиць. Сівши в човен, він переплив і прибув у своє місто.

#### Sunday, June 20, 2021 5th Sunday after Pentecost

**Tropar, tone 4:** When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the glorious news of the resurrection\* and cast off the ancestral condemnation,\* they proudly told the apostles:\* "Death has been plundered! Christ our God is risen\* granting to the world great mercy." Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen!

**Kondak, tone 4:** My Saviour and Deliverer\* from the grave as God has raised out of bondage the children of earth\* and shattered the gates of Hades;\* and as Master, He rose on the third day.

**Prokimen, tone 4:** How great are Your works, O Lord: You have made all things in wisdom.

*Verse:* Bless the Lord, O my soul; O Lord my God, You are exceedingly great.

**Epistle:** A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Romans. (10: 1 - 10)

Brothers and Sisters! My heart's desire, my prayer to God of the Israelites, is that they may be saved. Indeed, I can testify that they are zealous for God though their zeal is unenlightened. Unaware of God's justice and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the justice of God. Christ is the end of the law. Through him, justice comes to everyone who believes. Moses writes of the justice that comes from the law, "The one who observes the law shall live by it." But of the justice that comes from faith he says, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who shall go up into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down), or 'Who shall go down into the abyss?' (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead)." What is it he does say? "The word is near you, on your lips and in

your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach). For if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Faith in the heart leads to justification, confession on the lips to salvation.

Alleluia Verses: Poise yourself and advance in triumph and reign in the cause of truth, and meekness, and justice.

You have loved justice and hated iniquity.

**Gospel:** Matthew 8: 28 - 9: 1

At that time as Jesus approached the Gadarene boundary, he encountered two men coming out of the tombs. They were possessed by demons and were so savage that no one could travel along that road. With a sudden shriek they cried "Why meddle with us, Son of God? Have you come to torture us before the appointed time?" Some distance away a large herd of swine was feeding. The demons kept appealing to him, "If you expel us, send us into the herd of swine.' He answered, "Out with you!" At that they came forth and entered the swine. The whole herd went rushing down the bluff into the sea and were drowned. The swineherds took to their heels, and upon their arrival in the town related everything that had happened, including the story about the two possessed men. The upshot was that the entire town came out to meet Jesus. When they caught sight of him, they begged him to leave their neighbourhood. Then he reentered the boat, made the crossing, and came back to his own town.

### Sunday Liturgy Registration Process

As you will have learned from your news sources, due to a perceived shift in the Covid-19 situation, the Government of Manitoba has issued changes to the safety restrictions affecting our daily lives, including the practice of our faith. In light of the latest government directives, we can see the following changes to the pastoral and liturgical activity of our parishes within the Archeparchy beginning Saturday, 26 June 2021:

"Faith-based gatherings" may expand to 25% of the typical capacity of the church, but up to a maximum of twenty-five (25) people. Outdoor gatherings may be attended by a maximum of fifty (50) people. This number, as clarified in the past, does *not* include the essential liturgical and livestreaming personnel.

In-Person Option to attend Sunday Services: To register to attend the 10:00 am Sunday Divine Liturgy in our church, please call the registration line for each Sunday that you would like to attend, at 204-582-4466, and leave a message or send an email to <u>BVMParish@shaw.ca</u>. In the message, please leave your name, phone number, and the number of people who wish to attend. You will be notified after 3:00 pm on Friday as to whether or not we will be able to welcome you to Divine Liturgy that Sunday. Everyone must follow Covid-19 safety protocols regarding facemasks, handwashing, sanitizing and physical distancing. If you are not comfortable to attend services at this time, please follow the Liturgy by using the on-line option. On-Line Option to attend services: Sunday Liturgies and daily services are provided live via YouTube and also Facebook.
