



Prokimen, tone 4: I will feed them with the best of wheat, and with honey from the rock I will fill them.

Verse: Sing joyfully to God our strength.

Epistle: A reading from the First Letter of the Holy

Brothers and Sisters: I received from the Lord what I handed on to you, namely, that the Lord Jesus on the night in which he was betrayed took bread, and after he had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after the supper, he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." Every time, then, you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes! This means that whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily sins against the body and blood of the Lord. A man should examine himself first; only then should he eat of the bread and drink of the cup. He who eats and drinks without recognizing the body eats and drinks a judgment on himself. That is why many among you are sick and infirm, and why so many are dying. If we were to examine ourselves, we would not be falling under judgment in this way; but since it is the Lord who judges us, he chastens us to keep us from being condemned with the rest of the world.

Alleluia Verses: The eyes of all look hopefully to you, and you give them their food in due season.

The Feast of the Most Holy Eucharist

"He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has life everlasting and I will raise him up on the last day."

The Divine Liturgy, as the Unbloody Sacrifice, is the centre of worship and the spiritual life of the Catholic Church. The reason for this is that, at the Divine Liturgy, the Most Holy Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, a sacrament which surpasses all other sacraments, is offered up to God.

At the Last Supper, Jesus Christ instituted the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist, so that the Holy Sacrifice might be offered up in the Church through all ages as the spiritual food of the faithful.

By adopting the holy faith from Byzantium, our Ukrainian Church also accepted its thousand-year old tradition regarding the worship of the Holy Eucharist. Here, it may be worthwhile to recall the teaching and prescription of the Servant of God, Metropolitan Andrew Sheptysky, on the worship of the Most Holy Eucharist. He demanded that utmost reverence be shown to the Blessed Sacrament on the Altar. "The holiest place in the church," he says in a pastoral letter of 1900, "is the Altar of God and on it, the tabernacle – the place of Christ.... The altar is the holiest place because the most Holy Sacrifice of the Divine Liturgy is offered on it, and because the all-holy Lord of heaven and earth dwells upon it under the species of bread. That place is so sacred....

The Second Vatican Council directs that we join our participation in the Divine Liturgy with Holy Communion: "The perfect form of participation in the Divine Liturgy, whereby the faithful, after the priest's Communion, receive the Lord's Body from the same sacrifice, is strongly commended."

Let this Great and Holy Sacrament serve us a perfect fountain of love of God and of neighbour, of our faith and holiness, and as our guarantee of everlasting happiness according to the words of Christ: "Whoever eats my body and drinks my blood, shall have eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day." (John 6, 54)
