



Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (9: 11 - 14)

Brothers and Sisters! When Christ came as high priest of the good things which have come to be, he entered once for all into the sanctuary passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation. He entered, not with the blood of goats and calves, but with his own blood, and achieved eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifers ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal spirit offered himself up unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God!

Alleluia Verses: God gives me vindication, and has subdued peoples under me.

Making great the salvation of the king, and showing mercy to His anointed, to David, and to His posterity for ever.

Gospel: Mark 10: 32 - 45

At that time, Jesus taking the twelve aside once

more, began to tell them what was going to happen to him. "We are on our way up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be handed over to the chief priests and the scribes. They will condemn him to death and hand him over to the Gentiles, who will mock him and spit at him, flog him, and finally kill him. But three days later he will rise. Zebedee's sons, James and John, approached him, "Teacher," they said, "we want you to grant our request." "What is it?" he asked. They replied, "See to it that we sit, one at your right and the other at your left, when you come into your glory." Jesus told them, "You do not know what your are asking. Can you drink the cup I shall drink or be baptized in the same bath of pain as I?" "We can," they told him. Jesus said in response, "From the cup I drink of you shall drink; the bath I am immersed in you shall share. But as for sitting at my right or my left, that is not mine to give, it is for those to whom it has been reserved." The other ten, on hearing this, became indignant at James and John. Jesus called them together and said to them: "You know how among the Gentiles those who seem to exercise authority lord it over them; their great ones make their importance felt. It cannot be like that with you. Anyone among you who aspires to greatness must serve the rest; whoever wants to rank first among you must serve the needs of all. The Son of Man has not come to be served but to serve -- to give his life in ransom for the many."

2. Dress appropriately, as if you are in church physically. At the time of Holy Communion, make an act of "Spiritual Communion" to unite yourselves to God through prayer. Observe the proper gestures and responses during the Divine Liturgy.

3. Turn off ALL other devices and refrain from doing household chores.

Blessed Virgin Mary Parish: Sunday Liturgy Registration Process Dear Parishioners, the Government of Manitoba has loosened a number of Covid-19

restrictions, effective Saturday March 13th. The following are changes to the current public health orders with regard to places of worship:

*mask-use rules in churches are amended to allow masks not to be worn while household groups are seated together at a service, are appropriately distanced from other groups and are not singing;

*there is no requirement for faith-based organizations to take down contact information of congregants.
