1. Prepare a table with an appropriate cover, candles, Holy Bible and crucifix. Put yourself in the presence of the Lord and put your focus on the celebration of the Divine Liturgy.
2. Dress appropriately, as if you are in church physically. At the time of Holy Communion, make an act of “Spiritual Communion” to unite yourselves to God through prayer. Observe the proper gestures and responses during the Divine Liturgy.
3. Turn off ALL other devices and refrain from doing household chores.
