Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen!

Kondak of the Saints, tone 8: To You, O Lord, Author of all creation,* the universe offers the God-bearing martyrs as the first-fruit of nature.* Through their prayers and the intercession of the Mother of God* preserve your Church, your dwelling place, in perfect peace,* O most merciful One.

Prokimen, tone 8: Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

Verse: God is renowned in Judah, in Israel great is his name.

Epistle: A reading from the Epistle to the Hebrews. (11: 33 - 12: 2)

Brothers and Sisters! All who by faith conquered kingdoms, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, became strong in battle, and turned back foreign invaders. Women received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on

mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which included us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect. Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and persevere in running the race which lies ahead; let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

Alleluia Verses: *When the just cry out, the Lord hears them.*

Many are the troubles of just man, but out of them all the Lord delivers them.

Gospel: Matthew 10: 32 - 33, 37 - 38, 19: 27 - 30

The Lord said to his disciples: "Whoever acknowledges me before men I will acknowledge before my Father in heaven. Whoever disowns me before men I will disown before my Father in heaven. Whoever loves father or mother, son or daughter, more than me is not worthy of me. He who will not take up his cross and come after me is not worthy of me." Then it was Peter's turn to say to him: "Here we have put everything aside to follow you. What can we expect from it?" Jesus said to them, "I give you my solemn word, in the new age when the Son of Man takes his seat upon a throne befitting his glory, you who have followed me shall likewise take your places on twelve thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. Moreover, everyone who has given up home, brothers or sisters, father or mother, wife or children or property for my sake will receive many times as much and inherit everlasting life. Many who are first shall come last, and the last shall come first."

All Saints Sunday - Неділя Всіх Святих

*"We praise you, apostles, martyrs, prophets and all the saints,
and let us honor your holy memory, you are praying for us
Christ our God."*

(Exaltation on All Saints' Sunday).

The eighth Sunday after the feast of Easter, and the first Sunday after Pentecost, is called All Saints' Sunday. It completes the circle of moving holidays. On this day, our Eastern Church pays special homage to all those who are the fruit of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

"On this day, the Sunday after Pentecost," we read in the synaxarium, "we celebrate the feast of All Saints everywhere - in Asia, Libya, Europe, in the north and the south. This feast was instituted and ordered to be celebrated by our divine Fathers after the Ascension. The Spirit, as if showing us how the coming of the Holy Spirit affected the apostles, sanctified and made wise those of our nature to put them in the place of sinful angels, and brought them to Christ God: some through suffering and blood, others through perseverance in virtuous life."

Deacon Constantine (VI century) from Constantinople, in his sermon on the first Sunday after the Descent of the Holy Spirit, says: "The Greek Church commemorates with a remarkable and very bright holiday these glorious universal immortal flowers, given by the whole earth, constantly flooded by the rivers of the Holy Spirit."

We are invited not only to honor and to pray to the saints, but also to imitate their lives and holiness. All Christians are called to holiness by the power of the Holy Sacrament of Baptism and Holy Chrism. Every person, of every state and in all circumstances can be holy and is obliged to strive for holiness. To all of us, our Lord Jesus Christ says, "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect" (Matt. 5:48). And the holy apostle Paul reminds us of the duty of holiness: "This is the will of God, your holiness" (1 Thess. 4: 3).

Update on Church Hall (932 College Avenue):
