



Epistle: A reading from the Acts of the Apostles. (16: 16 - 34)

In those days as we were on our way out to the place of prayer that we met a slave girl who had a clairvoyant spirit. She used to bring substantial profit to her masters by fortune telling. The girl began to follow Paul and the rest of us shouting, "These men are servants of the Most High God; they will make known to you a way of salvation." She did this for several days until finally Paul became annoved, turned around, and said to the spirit, "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you, come out of her!" Then and there the spirit left her. When her masters saw that their source of profit was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the main square before the local authorities. They turned them over to the magistrate with this complaint: "These men are agitators disturbing the peace of our city! Furthermore, they are Jews, which means they advocate customs which are not lawful for us Romans to adopt or practice. The crowd joined in

them and ordered them to be floqged. After receiving many lashes they were thrown into prison, and the jailer was given instructions to guard them well. Upon receipt of these instructions he put them in maximum security, Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the going so far as to chain their feet to a stake. About midnight, while Paul and Silas were praving and singing hymns to God as their fellow prisoners listened, a severe earthquake suddenly shook the place, rocking the prison to its foundations. Immediately all the doors flew open and everyone's chains were pulled loose. The jailer woke up to see the prison gates wide open. Thinking that the prisoners had escaped, he drew "Do not harm yourself! We are all still here." The jailer called for a light, then rushed in and fell trembling at the feet of Paul and Silas. After a brief interval he led them out and said, "Men, what Prokimen, tone 8: Pray and give praise to the Lord must I do to be saved?" Their answer was, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, Verse: God is renowned in Judah, in Israel great is and all your household." They proceeded to announce the word of God to him and to everyone in his house. At that late hour of the night he took them in and bathed their wounds; then he and his whole household were baptized. He led them up into his house, spread a table before them, and joyfully celebrated with his whole family his newfound faith in God.

Re: COVID – 19 Pandemic

Archeparchy Directive # 10 (8 May 2021)

Prot. H/23/2021

To the Reverend Clergy, Religious Sisters and Laity

of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg:

Christ is Risen!

Христос Воскрес!

Not even a dozen days have passed since the last directives were issued, but due to a shift in the provincial regulations it is appropriate that we clarify the rules for activity within the Archeparchy. On 7 May 2021, citing concerns about the *third wave* of the Covid-19 coronavirus passing through our province, the Manitoba Health Authority announced a new public health order that greatly restricts interpersonal contact of any kind – including gatherings at churches, home visits, etc. [See attached 'Backgrounder']

To keep this notification as brief as possible, suffice it to say that the following restrictions – once in place in our Archeparchy, albeit in the earlier days of the pandemic – will be in effect in all Archeparchial parishes from midnight this Sunday <u>morning</u> (9 May 2019) until Sunday 30 May 2021.

1. Although clergy are asked to perform their basic priestly duties as best as possible, they may celebrate **liturgical services** only with a small essential team of individuals that must remain consistent throughout this period. This means the **parish priest**, a **cantor**, a **reader** and a **doorman/usher** and/or a sacristan. This number may include a **livestreaming**/ camera **operator** if the parish is so equipped. The parish priest will be responsible to form the team which should be kept to a number not exceeding five (5) persons unless there is some truly extenuating circumstance.

2. Services such as **Funerals**, **Weddings** and **Baptisms** may be categorized as "special public gatherings", thus allowing for up to ten (10) participants.

3. Holy Communion may be distributed outside of the Divine Liturgy, but only if it is possible to observe all pandemic and safe-environment protocols. Congregating even in the smallest of numbers (*e.g., when coming into or leaving the location where Holy Communion is received*) must not be permitted and, if required, the faithful must be reminded of this immediately.

4. The Sacrament of **Confession** may be offered on an individual basis – by appointment or by an effective, regulated onsite method. All the usual pandemic and safe-environment protocols are to be observed at all times.
