BTW Why do we pray the "Our Father", "Hail Mary" and the "Glory be.." after Liturgies for the deceased and after the Rosary and other similar moments?

In many cases, it directly relates to the concept of "indulgences". An indulgence is remittance of the temporal punishment due to sin. A "plenary indulgence" is the full remittance of such punishment. Some of the requirements needed to receive an indulgence for yourself or to obtain one for a deceased loved one, is 1. to make a good Confession, 2. worthily receive our Lord in Holy Communion, usually 3. perform some charitable or religious act AND... 4. "pray for the Intentions of the Pope". Thus... the three prayers mentioned above are added. During this Year of St Joseph we may obtain such a plenary indulgence every day! Also each day that we pray the Rosary. (there are several other
